2. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Ingredients: METHYL TRIMETHOXYSILANE 1-10%

CAS: 1185-55-3

[F] R11; [Xi] R36/38

Contains: Mixture of polydimethylsiloxanes, fillers and cross linkers

3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: No significant hazard.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)
